INTRODUCTION

Hello,

May I take this opportunity to thank you for grabbing you copy of this free report, which is a snapshot of my main guide *Trainer Track Profiles: Jumps 2016/17*.

What is it?

I have spent many hours in my HorseRaceBase account researching useful trainer stats for every UK jumps track since the beginning of 2013, plus some bonus stats for Ireland. I have used my subjective judgement on a trainer's record looking at number of bets, wins, win percentage, number of placed horses, profit to SP/ BFSP and Actual vs Expected- which is some sort of guide for how the selections have performed against market expectation (the bigger the number over 1.00 the better) and how they may do in future.

I have looked behind the top level stats to ensure that a trainer has not just relied on one good year or one particular horse.

Below I have annotated the different sections of the 'profile template' to explain the guide further.

You will struggle to find many of these stats elsewhere, presented in this easy to use way and for what I consider to be a value price. The aim is to help you home in on potential horses of interest before deciding whether to back them or not.

How should you use it?

With guides like this it really is up to you. You may use the stats as a guide, highlighting potential horses before you dig into the race in a bit more detail. You may just trust some of the stats and back the horse blind- occasionally they may find winners that make little sense on paper. You may only focus on those that are a certain price say.

My hope is that over the course of the season each section proves to be profitable systematically. But, I cannot promise that. These stats have not been tested live and sadly history is never a guarantee of future success. Any trainer can have a bad year with viruses etc. Ideally the 'micro angles' section will come out in front also.

The guide is essentially a collection of micro angles/systems to use as you see fit.

With any new venture like this that you may be using for the first time I would advise using small stakes or paper trading to start with – especially if using them as 'systems' without looking at the horses/races. I have every confidence that these stats – as they have done on the blog in the early part of the season- will highlight decent priced winners. We just have to back enough of them to make it pay.

Disclaimer

As always I encourage you to bet responsibly and only ever bet what you can afford to lose. There are no sure fire profit makers in this game and while I have tried my best to produce something that will help, I cannot guarantee profits. Your experience of racing must be enjoyable, first and foremost.

Trainer Track Profiles: JUMPS 2016/17

Annotated Profile

Each Track Profile uses the following template...

General Race Type

All Handicaps

(handicap hurdles + handicap chases)

(excludes Handicap Hunter Chases and Handicap Sellers/Claimers etc. Also excludes Handicap Novice Chasers and Handicap Novice Hurlers. Just looking at 'standard' handicap hurdles/chases, unless otherwise stated)

Where possible I have tried to highlight what I deem to be the 'top three' trainers. Sometimes there are fewer than this if I deem there to be no others worthy of inclusion. This is the same for every section that follows below in the 'General Race Type' category.

Handicap Hurdles

As above, this just looks at 'standard' handicap hurdles. It does not include stats for Novice Handicap Hurdles etc.

Handicap Chases

As above, this just looks at 'standard' handicap chases.

National Hunt Flat Races

Important: These stats cover ALL NHF races which can include standard NHF races and Maiden NHF races. If it is a NHF race these stats will be applicable.

Micro Angles

As with the first section these stats refer to all standard handicaps, excluding novice handicaps etc. The following stats cover both handicap hurdles and handicap chases combined.

Each of the following sections identifies just one trainer, where possible. Sometimes, especially for Handicap Chase Debut, there are 'none of note'. Often this will be because there were no trainers with more than one winner in the period.

Trainer/Jockey Combo

Some trainers book certain jockeys at certain tracks when their horse has a live chance. Or it may be the case that a trainer's horses go well here generally and that the jockey rides the track well. In any case, when a trainer books this jockey in a handicap at this track, it has paid over time to take note.

Class

Identifies trainers who have done well with horses in a certain class of race.

Distance

Identifies trainers who have done well with horses over a certain distance.

Going

Identified trainers whose horses have done well in certain going conditions. I have tried to focus on 'the extremes' looking for those who do well when the ground is testing, or firmer.

Age

This identifies those trainers who may target certain tracks with either their younger horses (age 5/6, of which there are plenty) or their older, more exposed runners.

Handicap Hurdle Debut

Some trainers are very good at ensuring a horse has plenty in hand when making handicap debut. Many of these will target certain tracks with such runners.

Handicap Chase Debut

As above. There are not too many of these but they are worth noting where they exist.

Horse Runs This Season

This angle helps highlight those trainers that may target certain tracks with fresher horses in the early part of the season – 0,1,2 runs in the season, or those who target tracks with those who may have run a few more times.

Horse Runs 90 Days: 0

Identifies which trainers horses are fit first time up after a lengthy break.
