

## Flat 2017: Trainer System Portfolio

Stats are from the beginning of 2014 and focus just on Flat Turf runners.

### 60+ Days Rest

*Here we are focusing on trainers who excel at producing horses after a break. These can often be overlooked by the market if the assumption is that they need the run. It is also possible that they ran poorly LTO which can put off some punters also.*

- Horse ran 60 or more days ago

- July / August /September / October

Note: Gosden appears to do best in the latter half of the year with this type and they are under-bet. Maybe punters assume there has been a problem/issue and prefer to stick with those that have proven fitness. This angle is applicable for all race types. Handicaps are best, profit wise, but you would have made +31 points above SP taking 'opening show' odds, 10 minutes before the off. I suspect taking morning prices would add even more profits. The money comes late for plenty of these. BFSP profit isn't too bad either. Those going off over 16/1 SP are 0/7,0p.

This approach is fairly simple, but sometimes you don't need to over-complicate things. There is no way to slice and dice further. If you wanted to go even more micro, you could just focus on handicap runners... 12/28, 16 places... +57 SP

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## Saeed Bin Suroor

- Class Move: Running at same class or dropped in class from last run
  - Drop in class includes a G1>G2, for example.
- 14/1 or shorter SP

Note: All of SBS runners 60+days rest sent off bigger than 14/1 SP are 0/30,3p in the period and it would indicate that the market is some sort of guide. Those returning from their break and moved up in class (14/1<) are 8/53,20p, -18 SP in this time and am happy to leave those. It should be noted that again, as with Gosden, taking 'opening odds' 10 mins before the off would have won you plenty more above SP... +50 points more with these ones. Again, taking odds earlier on may have added even more to the pot. Maybe the stable lads know when to unload!
