

## Racing to Profit Members' Club

### Section 2 Strategies : Other Ideas

#### Intro

The 'strategies' below are not advised to back systematically as such but may give you some ideas to help with shortlisting, although you're free to read the results and do as you please. The results for these angles haven't made the grade as systematic systems as such but I will still be keeping track of them for 2020. I reassess the current strategies every year and their intention was to provide a handful of systematic angles you could follow.

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#### JUMPS

##### Strategy S2A

Rules:

- Section 2 Jumps Qualifier
- 16/1-25/1 on morning odds, those I add next to the horse at around 8am every day.

#### Results

2018 Total:

- 1 point win: 13/241,53p, +26.6, +58.26 BFSP
- 1 point EW: 13/241,53p, +100
- 1/2 point EW: 13/241,53p, +50
- 5.3% win SR, , 22% win|place SR, 24% ROI 1 point win BFSP, 20% ROI for each way.

2019 Total (End July)

- 1 point win: 10/224, 41p, -13
- 1 point EW: 10/224, 41p, +2.05
- ½ point EW: 10/224, 41p, +1.02

Notes

2019 didn't replicate 2018, like many of my strategies. However, the profit, esp EW, didn't really justify the quantity of bets. Obviously, it's a big odds strategy with some hefty losing runs

## Strategy w1

Rules:

- Section 2 Jumps Qualifier
- Horse won on last start (w1)

Results 2018

- Total: 229 bets / 56 wins / 90p / +33.63

Results 2019

- End April: 233 bets / 49 wins / 100p / +5.925

Notes: this strategy had a poor first five months of 2019, losing -44 points. It had a very strong second half to the year, dragging it into profit. It may well have a decent 2020. Finding value with LTO winners can be challenging and after last year I wanted to see how 2020 went. 51 horses did place and had a few more of those won the profit would be greater. If nothing else a decent 'way in' to shortlisting potential bets.

## Strategy S3A

Rules:-

- Horse is listed in section 2 as a 'Jumps' qualifier
- Horse has an **ES+** symbol next to their name, indicating that they qualified against one of my stats angles that had at least 10 winners, and a 25% win SR in the research period. Any horse with an **ES+** next to their name is an 'S3A' qualifier

Results 2018

- Total: 255 bets / 56 wins / 88p / +74

Results 2019

- Total: 349 bets / 51 wins / 112 / -1.605

Notes: As yet this doesn't have three years of live play and last year was a poor return given the number of bets. It's not impossible that 2020 repeats 2018 but that awaits to be seen. Again this angle can be a decent way in given the stats research behind the qualifier as per the rules above (historical trainer angle having at least 10 winners and 25% win SR)

## FLAT

### Strategy S1

Rules:

- Section 2 Flat Qualifier
- Horse is Double or Treble Top Rated: Two of **H1 I1 G1**, or all three.

Results 2017: Total: 72 bets / 17 wins / +17.2

Results 2018: Total: 93 bets / 23 wins / 42p / +9.90

Results 2019: 76 bets / 14 wins / 31p / -3.65

Notes: This angle is a useful 'way in' given it finds winners but I'm not sure the profits justify the effort, systematically at least. There doesn't appear to be much 'value' in these angles.
